-PRAY: Our opening Psalm this Sunday is Psalm 84:10-12. As you pray, mediate on the fact that there is no better or safer place than in the presence of God. Remember that God is a sun (light, sight, warmth, growth) and shield (protector, defender, strength) and that He is the One who gives grace/favor and honor. Trust in Him again this morning!

Sermon Text: Romans 14:1-12
